

ERECTION OF RUBBER RUBBLE CHUTES COLUMNS

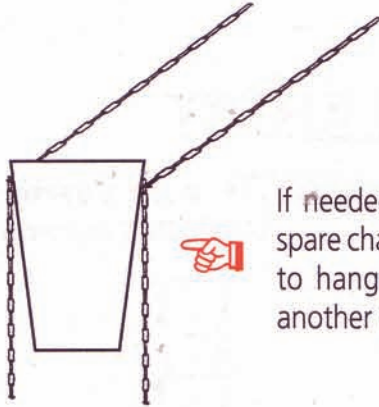
WRONG



RIGHT

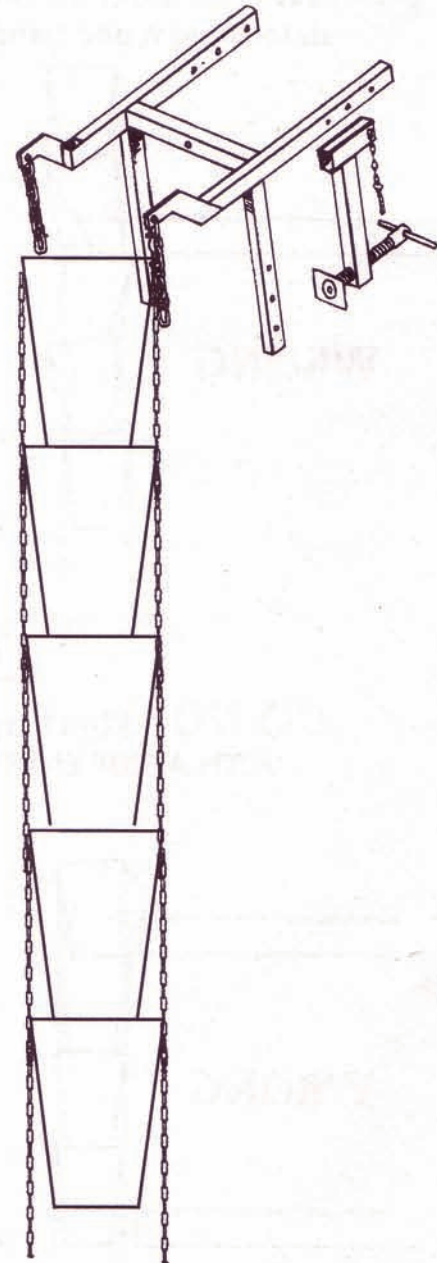


The chute chains must hang **down** from the chute, **never upwards**.

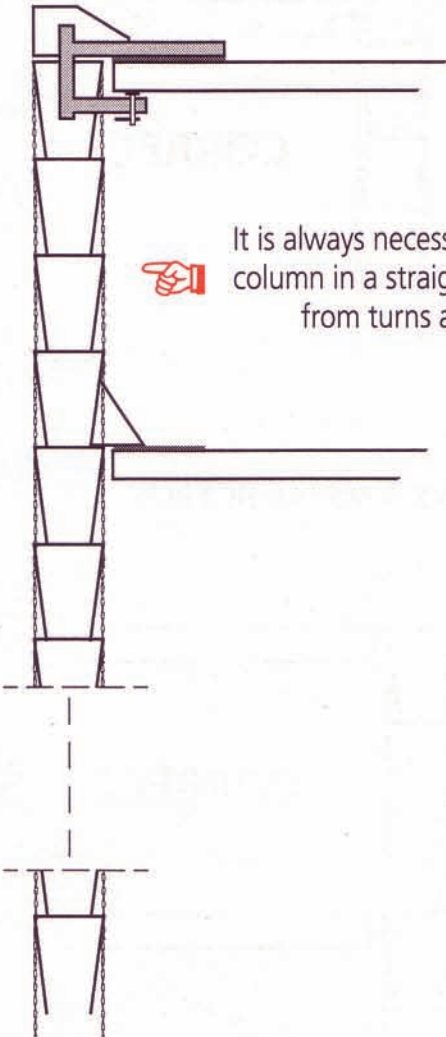


If needed, we can supply two spare chains and security hooks to hang the first chute from another type of system.

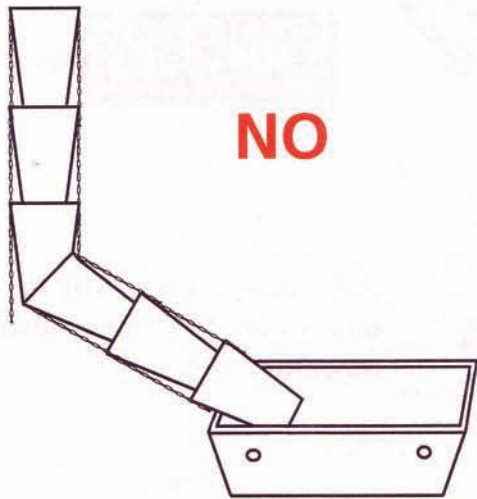
The column must be attached to the structure by a suitable security system, such as our own support frames 



It is always necessary to erect the column in a straight fashion, free from turns and twists.



BENDS OR TURNS: Do **not** hang the column this way



NO

SMOOTH CURVE: THIS IS THE CORRECT PROCEDURE. COMPLETELY VERTICAL IS BEST

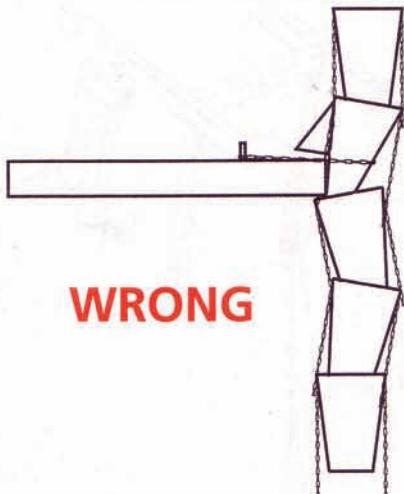

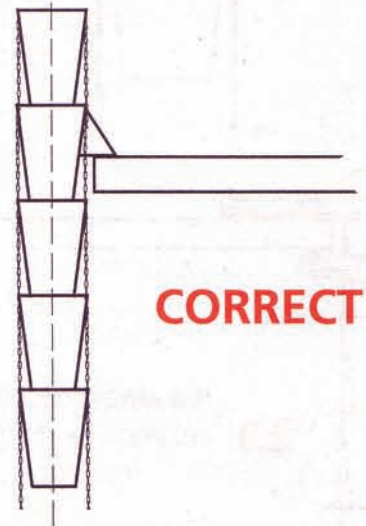
CHUTES WITH SIDE ENTRY

DO NOT tie the chute directly to the structure, deforming it and bending the column

ALWAYS keep a vertical and **FREE HANGING** column



WRONG

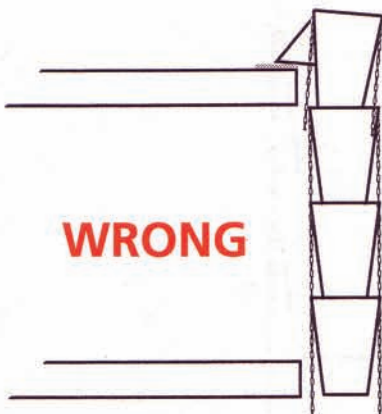


CORRECT

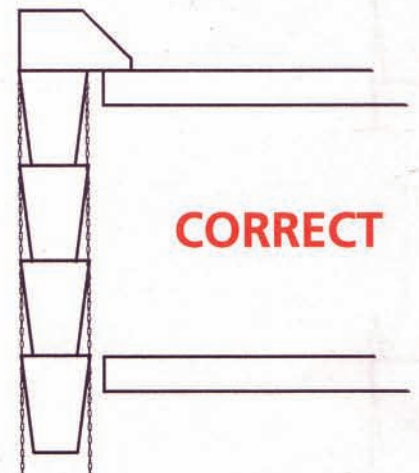
TOP METAL HOPPER

DO NOT START THE COLUMN WITH A SIDE ENTRY CHUTE

USE ALWAYS A METAL HOPPER
